INTRODUCTION

SupremInkTM won't dry out on the ink slab surface—but dries almost immediately on contact with the fingerprint card. Only a few drops are needed to roll a thin, even layer of ink—perfect for producing fingerprints with superbridge detail.

FEATURES

- · Low Viscosity Ink—makes for easier dispensing and rolling
- · Quick Drying—ready before the next fingerprint is taken
- · Consistent Formulation—the first drop is as good as the first
- Fast Cleanup—easily removed from fingers and glass slabs by rinsing with water and wiping with a light towel on steel slabs
- Metered Dispensing—1 drop = 3.5ml (0.19 fl. oz.)

PROCEDURE

- Hold dispenser bottle 1 inch above a glass or smooth-surfaced plate or slab. Evenly distribute 6 drops on inking surface. Wipe off dispenser nozzle before replacing cap.
- Use a soft rubber roller to roll out a smooth film of ink. The ink should be rolled until a smooth and even film covers the plate or slab, especially on the edge nearest you, which will be the rolling edge of the slab.





- 3. When rolling fingerprints, hold the finger securely, and try to roll from one side of the fingernail to the other. The finger should be kept at right angles to the edge of the slab so that the impression which is made on the ink should be almost square.
- 4. Use slight pressure when placing the inked finger on the fingerprint card.
- 5. Easily remove ink residue from fingers and ink slab with water and wipe with a light towel.
